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## **Introduction**

Every year Scouts from The Lakeview District gather together at Camporee to compete with each other, meet other Scouts within the district, and most importantly, show their Scout spirit!

## **Theme**

You are invited to join us at the 2017 Lakeview District Camporee at SR2 Buchanan Springs April 21 – 23, 2017. The camporee theme is the Ultimate Camporee Adventure and represent skills Scouts would need if they were stranded in the wild.

## **Registration Details**

Registration and payment online is taking place now continuing through April 14<sup>th</sup>. Costs will be \$12.00 for each Scout and \$5.00 for each adult participating. Troops can register and pay online at: <http://www.lakeviewdistrict.org/events-camporee.php>

## **Uniforms**

All scouts are expected to wear their “Class A” Scout uniform during check-in, morning and evening flag ceremonies, campfire, and Sunday morning chapel for those participating. During the day on Saturday, Scouts can wear their Scout activity uniform (Scout shorts and troop t-shirt).

## **Campgrounds for Camporee**

The Camporee will be held at SR2, Buchanan Springs Canoe Base. Troop campsites will be assigned based upon their timing with registration. The number of Scouts and adults dictate which campsite they will be assigned to.

## **Parking**

Parking space is very limited near the campsites. One vehicle + Troop trailer will be allowed near the assigned campsite.

## **Campfire & Awards Presentation**

The evening campfire will be performed mostly by Troops with adult involvement. We will be accepting nominations for skits and songs to be selected for the campfire. If your troop would like to participate, please contact Larry Dew at [larrydew128@att.net](mailto:larrydew128@att.net). Skits and songs involving audience participation is encouraged! During the campfire, special awards will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers for each event.

## **Order of Arrow**

After the campfire, everyone will process from the campfire ring in the ceremony field above the campsites near the entrance. All OA candidates chosen by their Troops are eligible for the Order of Arrow will be recognized in a call-out ceremony.

## **Campsite**

Don't forget to keep your campsite clean along with practicing "Leave No Trace". There will be a special award to the troop that leaves the cleanest campsite.

## **Meals**

Troops are responsible for all meals throughout the weekend.

## **Medical Consent Forms**

Scoutmasters **MUST** bring medical consent forms (Parts A and B) for all participating Scouts. A tour plan is recommend but not required since this is a Council activity. Scouts without medical forms will not be able to participate.

## **Staff**

We need Leaders and Scouts to serve on camporee staff. Each participating troop is requested to provide at least two Leaders not directly committed to troop or patrol supervision at the camporee to serve on Camporee Staff. Volunteers are needed to plan and supervise camporee events, the campfire and chapel Sunday morning.

## **Venturing Units**

Venturing Units are invited to participate. Please follow the registration and payment instructions found within this Leaders Guide.

## **GO TO THE CAMPOREE!**

Troops should arrive Friday between 6:00 - 9:30 pm to check-in at Camporee Headquarters, located in the Service Building in the center of the camp. Unload equipment and set-up their campsites.

Upon arrival, the Scoutmaster and SPL should check-in at Headquarters to turn in the final registration guide found in this packet and receive updated Camporee instructions and agenda.

## Troop Awards

There will be two Troop Awards during Camporee via the Troop Gateway and Leave No Trace. The Gateway award will be based upon the best gateway constructed by the troop at their campsite. The Leave No Trace award will be based upon the troop that leaves their campsite following “Leave No Trace” practices. This award will be presented at the following District Roundtable meeting in May.

## Patrol Awards

The patrol awards will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers in the following events. Further details on each event and how they will be scored can be found later in this guide. All events will run throughout the morning and throughout the afternoon.
